

MENTAL HEALTH ACCESS PROGRAM

You need to bring in proof of household income for all household members over the age of 18 and a completed MHAP application.

Primary Documents (1 or more of the following)

v	Income Type	Proof of Income (all members of household)
	Salaries/Wages	copy of signed federal tax return from the household filer that includes tax dependents <u>or</u> last 30 days of pay stubs for all employed persons 18 years of age or older who reside in the household <u>or</u> most recent W-2 or 1099 forms for all household wage earners 18 years of age or older
	Self-employed	copy of signed federal income tax return
	Social Security/Pension	copy of award statement or proof of Income letter
	Disability	copy of Social Security Disability Insurance (SSDI) award statement
	Unemployment	copy of benefit notification letter signed and dated by state of Illinois
	Workers' compensation /public disability benefits	copy of signed and dated court order awarding WC/PDB payments.
	Veteran benefits	copy of VA summary benefit award letter
	Welfare assistance	copy of Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) award letter

Additional Documents (as needed)

v	Financial Hardship	Additional Documentation
	Divorce/Separation	copy of Divorce Decree or Separation Agreement signed and dated by the court
	Insurance-related (i.e., high deductible, no mental health benefits, mental health benefits exhausted)	copy of Form 1095-A (health insurance marketplace statement or Form 1095-B (health coverage) or Form 1095-C (employee-provided health insurance offer and coverage)
	Death of primary wage earner	copy of death certificate or obituary
	Bankruptcy	copy of bankruptcy discharge papers
	High medical debt	Proof of all outstanding medical debts or bills (copies of bills, statements, late notices, etc.)
